



What happens if the Project Development Plan is not approved for certification?

If upon consideration of the application the VIEDA decides the Project does not comply with the requirements, the VIEDA shall notify the developer in writing stating the areas the Project fails to meet the criteria, which shall be made available for public review.

The VIEDA shall allow the development sponsor up to sixty (60) days to cure any defects. If the development sponsor fails to cure the defects within the sixty (60) day period, the VIEDA shall deny the certification of project, and any re-submittal of the Project shall require a new application.
